
Frontal lobe

- This is behind the forehead
- Referred to as the conductor of the brain
- To name a few functions: attention, memory, speech, decision-making, risk assessment, problem-solving, personality characteristics, and emotions.



Parietal lobe

- Located behind the frontal lobe
- It's the middle part of the brain
- Responsible for interpreting our senses such as pain, vision, touch
- It's also responsible for identifying objects and understanding spatial relationships.

Temporal lobe

- Tucked behind the ears on side of your head
- This holds bulk of your memories
- It involves speech ability to understand and speak, short term memory, musical rhythm, some smell recognition

Occipital lobe

- This is at very back of your head behind the parietal lobe
- This is responsible for your visual processing
